King County Sheriff John Urquhart



Sheriff John Urquhart has served the citizens of Washington State as a police officer for over 37 years, the last 25 as a full-time member of the King County Sheriff's Office. His career has included stints as a Patrol Officer, Field Training Officer, Master Police Officer, Sergeant, street-level vice/narcotics detective, public information officer and administrative aide to two

sheriffs. He has investigated everything from property crimes to homicides. Early in his career he was selected by his peers as the *Officer of the Year* at his precinct and then as the *Officer of the Year* for the entire Sheriff's Office.

Sheriff Urquhart grew up in North Seattle, and after high school he attended the University of Washington. He graduated from the *School of Business* with a Bachelor's Degree in *Business, Government, and Society*. He began a business in a nearby suburb, and grew the business for several years before selling it to "pursue other interests".

John joined the Sheriff's Office (then the King County Police) full-time in 1988, and eventually became the public information officer. He had a reputation, not only with the press but also with the community, for being honest, straight-forward, and transparent as he provided both information about the good and the bad. A *Seattle Times* article in September of 2011 called him "...blunt speaking... known for his honesty and ruthless wit...who sees the media as an integral part of the democratic process".

Sheriff Urquhart retired in early 2012 and promptly filed to run for Sheriff against a veteran police chief appointed by the King County Council to complete the term of the previous sheriff who retired early. A resounding victory in the November election made him King County's 33rd Sheriff!
